American Red Cross and Ballston Spa National Bank partner for annual blood drives

Ballston Spa National Bank (BSNB) and the American Red Cross are teaming up to sponsor two community blood drives on Monday, Feb. 9, 2015. The blood drives will be held from noon to 6 p.m. at BSNB Corporate Plaza, 990 State Route 67, in Ballston Spa and at the Malta Community Center, 1 Bayberry Drive in Malta.

Recent winter weather conditions and widespread flu have impacted some donors' ability to give blood or platelets. Since the beginning of January, dozens of blood drives have been canceled in the state due to the weather and as a result, hundreds of donations went uncollected. The American Red Cross and BSNB urge healthy, eligible donors to take this opportunity to make an appointment to give.

The Red Cross is asking eligible blood donors of all blood types to donate blood during the winter months to strengthen the community's blood supply.

Approximately every two seconds a patient in the United States needs blood. That's why your blood donation through the Red Cross is so important. Walk-ins are always

welcome, but donors are encouraged to schedule an appointment in advance by calling 1-800-RED CROSS or by visiting redcrossblood.org.
