All BSNB branches to operate exclusively through drive-thru service.

Beginning Wednesday, March 18, all BSNB branches will operate exclusively through drive-thru service. In addition, the bank's Latham Office at 1207 Troy-Schenectady Road, which does not offer drive-thru service, will be closed until further notice.

Dowd, president and CEO. "The steps we are taking will help ensure the safety of our customers and employees during this unprecedented time."
